



Before you get started, here are some TERMS you need to know:

Mental Health First Aid (MHFA)- One of our core curricula that teaches adults to support other adults who may be experiencing a mental health challenge or crisis.

Youth MHFA- One of our core curricula that teaches adults to support adolescents (age 12-18) who may be experiencing a mental health challenge or crisis.

Instructor- Someone who teaches Mental Health First Aid and/or Youth Mental Health First Aid. If you're reading this, you're likely considering becoming certified as an instructor!

First Aider- A participant in a MHFA or YMHFA course.

First Aider Classes

Please see the table below to get familiar with the available curricula and delivery methods. Course times do not include breaks. Plan for more breaks for virtual courses.

Instructor Training

All new instructors will be trained in the Mental Health First Aid 2nd Edition version of the curricula. Please check for compatibility if you have existing instructors within your organization.

Instructor Candidates should have:

- Previously **completed** a Mental Health First Aid or Youth Mental Health First Aid course and hold an **active certification** in the curricula for which they are applying.
- **Knowledge** of, or experience with mental health challenges (either personally, professionally, or both)
- Prior **experience** training adult learners
- A **commitment** and **strategic plan** to roll out Mental Health First Aid in the community

Things you should know...

- Only Instructors trained to deliver the 2016 curriculum may facilitate MHFA 1st Edition courses.
- Instructors are **required to provide a manual** for each participant that is theirs to keep. Be sure to budget for this as you develop your business plan.
- There is **no standard instructor rate** for the instructor time when teaching. Instructors are free to set their training fee as they see fit.
- **Instructor certification lasts indefinitely**, as long as instructor teaches at least 3 courses per anniversary year. If instructors are dually certified (in both the Adult and Youth curricula), they must teach 3+ classes per anniversary year, with at least 1 of each curricula. It is recommended that instructors seeking dual certification train at least one course before applying for additional instructor certifications.
- **First Aider certification lasts for 3 years**. At that time, a First Aider may complete another training or take a brief refresher course online for \$30.
